At the end of April 2023, the 20-member Supervisory Board of MAHLE GmbH, with equal representation of shareholders and employees, reconstituted itself in rotation after the shareholder representatives were newly elected by the shareholders' general assembly and the employee representatives by the employees of the MAHLE Group in Germany.

The shareholders' general assembly of MAHLE GmbH elected Professor Dr.-Ing. Achim Kampker as a new shareholder representative to the Supervisory Board. He is the founder and chair of Production Engineering of E-Mobility Components (PEM) at RWTH Aachen University.

Claudia Diem, a former member of the Board of Management of BW Bank, and Dr. Rolf Breidenbach, former Chairman of the Management Board of Hella GmbH & Co. KGaA, have been shareholder representatives on the board since January 2023.
