

This data processing notice provides you with information relating to the processing of your personal data by MAHLE International GmbH within its group companies, departments and groups, and relating to your rights pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"). Which data is processed specifically, and how this is used, depends largely on the contractually agreed services and obligations. As a result, not all parts of this notice may apply.

Which data sources and what data do we use?

We process the personal data that we receive from you in connection with our business relationship, e.g. via a self-disclosure. We also process – insofar as is necessary in order to fulfill our obligations – personal data that we permissibly obtain from publicly accessible sources (e.g. commercial register and register of associations, the press, media, information databases, the Internet) or that is transferred to us legitimately by other MAHLE companies or third parties (e.g. credit agencies).

The personal data concerned includes master data (e.g. title, name, (business) address), contact data (e.g. business telephone, fax, mobile phone number and business e-mail address), identification data (e.g. ID card data) and authentication data (e.g. specimen signature). This may also include order data, contract and billing data for the fulfillment of our contractual obligations, documentation data (e.g. excerpt from the commercial register), bank data, tax data (e.g. VAT identification number) or data necessary for processing an inquiry and, where applicable, creditworthiness data, advertising and sales data and other data from comparable categories (all together "personal data").

Why do we process your data (purpose of processing) and what is the legal basis?

MAHLE processes (for example, collects, orders, stores, adapts, uses, transmits, links, deletes, etc.; "processing") personal data in accordance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and the German Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz, "BDSG"). The processing of personal data is carried out for the following purposes ("purpose"):

a) For the fulfillment of contractual obligations or the implementation of pre-contractual measures pursuant to Art. 6 (1b) GDPR

Data is processed primarily in order to fulfill our obligations arising from the contractual business relationship between us and you (e.g. purchase agreement, lease agreement, service agreement, contract for work or rental agreement), in order to carry out pre-contractual measures that take place upon request (e.g. for the submission of a bid) and as part of a contract initiation (e.g. during contractual negotiations).

Security

Through organizational and technical measures, we ensure that your data processed by us is protected against manipulation, loss,

b) On the basis of legal obligations pursuant to Article 6 (1c) GDPR

As a company, we are also required by various legal obligations (e.g. tax laws) to collect certain personal data from you and to make this available to specific, mostly public, bodies. The purposes of processing include, but are not limited to, the fulfillment of documentation and retention obligations under commercial and tax law.

c) As part of a balancing of interests pursuant to Article 6 (1f) GDPR

To the extent necessary, we process your data beyond the actual performance of the contract in order to protect our legitimate interests or those of third parties. For example:

- Processing of general inquiries relating to our products and services
- Assertion of legal claims and defense in case of legal disputes
- Safeguarding IT security and IT operations in our company
- Prevention and investigation of criminal offenses
- Video surveillance for the preservation of domiciliary rights and for the collection of evidence in the event of robberies or fraud (cf. Section 4 BDSG)
- Measures for the security of buildings and facilities (e.g. access controls)
- Measures for safeguarding domiciliary rights
- Measures relating to business management and the further development of services and products
- Risk management in our company

MAHLE processes your personal data only for purposes other than those described, insofar as a legal provision permits this or you have consented to the changed purpose of data processing. In the case of further processing by MAHLE for purposes other than those for which the data was originally collected, we will inform you about these other purposes before further processing and provide you with all other relevant information.

Data recipients or data recipient categories

We disclose the personal data of our suppliers and service providers only to entities within the MAHLE Group or external recipients outside of our company that require this data in order to fulfill our contractual and legal obligations, and only where we are legally obligated to disclose or are authorized to disclose personal data as part of a balancing of interests.

Data transfer to third countries

We transfer personal data to internal and external recipients in states outside the European Union (third countries) or to international organizations only where the aforementioned legal basis applies and in accordance with Article 44 et seq. or 49 GDPR.

Data retention period and deletion of your personal data

We process and store your personal data as long as this is necessary for the fulfillment of our contractual and legal (retention) obligations under commercial and tax law, or in order to protect our legitimate interests.

In all other cases, we delete your personal data as soon as the purpose for which we have collected and processed the data no longer applies.

Each data subject has the following rights:

- The right of access pursuant to Article 15 GDPR
- The right to rectification of inaccurate data pursuant to Article 16 GDPR
- The right to erasure pursuant to Article 17 GDPR
- The right to restriction of processing pursuant to Article 18 GDPR
- The right to data portability pursuant to Article 20 GDPR
- The right to object pursuant to Art. Article 21 GDPR
- The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority pursuant to Article 77 GDPR.

Obligation to provide data for a business relationship

Within the scope of our business relationship, you must provide the personal data required for the purpose of establishing, executing and terminating a business relationship and for the fulfillment of the associated contractual obligations, or that we are obligated by law to collect. Without this data, we will generally not be able to enter into, perform or terminate a contract with you.

If you do not provide us with the required information and documents, we will not be able to enter into, perform or terminate the business relationship with you.

Notice concerning automated decision-making

As a general rule, we do not use fully automated decision-making, as defined in Article 22 GDPR, in order to establish or perform business relationships. If these procedures are used by us in individual cases, we will notify you separately of this and inform you of your rights to the extent required by law.
